

# Lake Buchanan White & Striped Bass

The following descriptions may be used to identify species

The photo of fish from Lake Buchanan, shows, from the top: White, Hybrid and Striped Bass. The White is approximately 10", the Hybrid and Striped Bass are approximately 18" long.



## Descriptions

### White Bass (Top)

- Back of tongue has 1 tooth patch
- Deep body, more than 1/3 of length
- Stripes faint, only one extends to tail
- Seldom exceeds 3 lbs.
- 2nd dorsal spine 2/3 or more length of 3rd spine
- **Bag limit, 25, Min. length, 10"**

**Bag limit, 5, of any combination,  
Hybrid and Striped Bass**

### Striped Bass (Bottom)

- Back of tongue has 2 distinct tooth patches
- Body slender, less than 1/3 of length
- Stripes distinct, several extend to tail
- Seldom exceeds 20 lbs.
- 2nd dorsal spine 1/2 length of 3rd spine
- **Bag limit, 5, Min length, 18"**

### Hybrid Striped Bass (Middle)

- Back of tongue has 2 distinct tooth patches
- Body deep, more than 1/3 of length
- Stripes distinct, somewhat broken, several extend to tail
- Seldom exceeds 10 lbs.
- 2nd dorsal spine 2/3 length of 3rd spine
- **Bag limit, 5, Min. length, 18"**
