In 2007 we accomplished the following:

- Stocked the lake with approx. 150,000 Hybrid Striper fingerlings
- Provided a Certified Scale, for weighing record fish, located at the Thunderbird Resort
- Stocked the lake with approx. 10,000 Channel Catfish fingerlings
- Supported the Boys and Girls Club Fishing Tournament with trophies and workers
- Distributed Fish Identification Flyers around the lake
- Raised over \$8500 with Casino Night and Fish Fry fund raisers
- Participated in the Texas Parks and Wildlife Expo in Austin
- Hosted ten programs at our monthly meetings to keep our members informed
