2011 Brush Pile Activity

We cut about 900 Cedar trees on February 12 at Ron Abshier's place, bundled and loaded them on TPWD boats on February 14, at the north side of Shaw Island. TPWD biologists put them in the lake as fish habitat. They refurbished six existing piles and added five new ones. A location map and GPS coordinates are available on our web site and at our meetings. Since starting this activity in 2008, we have put over 3000 trees in the lake!
